Lincoln Caverns has been serving the Girl Scout Community for over thirty years. By providing activities that are both engaging and educational, Lincoln Caverns offers Girl Scouts an opportunity to learn and make memories that will last a lifetime. Girl Scout Cadettes, Seniors, and Ambassadors Programs are available year-round in our Indoor Learning Center.

Event dates are ideal for smaller troops. To accommodate more girls, registration on these event dates is limited to Girl Scouts, leaders, and GSUSA registered parents. Event dates give girls an opportunity to join other scouts from Pennsylvania and nearby states to complete a girl-centered learning adventure. All programs include a pre-tour program about cave conservation and a cavern tour. Advance registration is required for all event day programs. Registration closes ten days prior to the event, or when the event has been booked to capacity.

Visit for a single patch program or stay for the weekend, earning two patches! Detailed times, descriptions, and fees are listed on the following pages. Event dates can be reserved with a small per person deposit and payment in full is due two weeks prior to the event. Perfect for troops of mixed age levels – Cadettes, Seniors, and Ambassadors. Patch	Each program includes 5+ hours of related informational sessions, a pre-tour program about	
	caves and a 90-minute cavern tour through two beautiful crystal caverns.	
GEOLOGY ROCKS	Discover the depths of geoscience studies. Scouts will investigate rock & mineral properties, while learning to identify them. They will dive deep into geologic time while exercising their creativity and looking at sample fossil specimens. Geological features of karst terrain will be examined, while discovering how caves are part of our groundwater system. Each scout will put together a rock collection to take home.	
DIRECTIONS MATTER	Learn about fun outdoor 'hide & seek' orienteering activities – geocaching and letterboxing! Girl Scouts will learn to operate a handheld GPS unit, set coordinates, and find waypoints. They will use teamwork and games to discuss compasses, mapmaking, geocaching and letterboxing lingo, safety, and rules. A scout-centered geocache hunt awaits at the end of the day. Each Girl Scout makes a letterboxing craft to use in their own geocaching adventures.	
GOING BATTY	Bats are the focus of this fun patch program, as they are a key "nuts & bolts" species in ecosystems around the world. Discover their importance to the habitats they live in, investigate different bat families, and research local bat species that live in your neighborhood. Complete the patch by working with your troop to build a bat house.	
EXPLORE MORE	Explore More and learn about the exciting underground world the way explorers see it. Girls will learn about cave expeditions, explorers, and caving safety. Caving explorations frequently involve scientific research, which girls will be able to experience first-hand by participating in a series of experiments within the cave.

Our programs are specifically designed to capture the attention of teenage Girl Scouts and encourage them to be active conservationists and leaders in their communities by drawing attention to themes in the geosciences, wildlife, and recreational use of outdoor spaces. 

TO REGISTER:

- 1. Choose an Event Date(s) that works best for the most members of your troop.
- 2. Reserve with a deposit!
 - a. \$10/person for single patch events
 - b. \$20/person for combo patch events
 - c. Deposit fees are made per person to reserve a space in the program. Only deposit fees for individuals attending the program and paying in full will be credited towards final payment. Deposit fees paid for those unable to attend are forfeited. Deposits are nontransferrable and non-refundable.
 - d. Deposits may be made online through the Calendar of Events, by phone, email, or USPS.
 - e. Deposits reserve your program space, but final payment must be made two weeks prior to the event.
- 3. Fill out the attached registration form and roster.
- 4. Make a payment for the full registration amount, minus the deposit paid for the number of people attending. All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable; however, substitutions can be made.  - > All rates are subject to change and will be confirmed at the time of reservation/receipt of deposit.
 - > Deposits and registration fees are non-refundable, and dates are non-transferable. If a registered group member is unable to attend, substitutions are encouraged and welcomed. Rainchecks will be given to individuals only in the event of extenuating circumstances and must be used within one year of the originally scheduled program.
 - > Events are held rain or shine! Events are rescheduled ONLY if adverse weather makes travel to Lincoln Caverns unsafe.
 - If any of your group members have experienced recent signs of illness including fever, cough, shortness of breath, vomiting, diarrhea, etc., we expect them to stay home and reschedule with us within the next year. Please continue to monitor current information from your council, government officials, and the CDC for health and safety recommendations.
 - Most workshops, facilities, gift shop and restrooms are wheelchair accessible, however only a portion of the cavern tour has access for scouts with physical disabilities. We will be glad to arrange a personal tour for a Scout and their chaperone if they have specialized needs and are unable to take the tour with the rest of their group; however, this MUST be requested with your registration, as an additional staff person will be necessary.
 - > <u>INDOOR LODGING</u>: 'Slumber Party style' lodging is included in programs bring your sleeping bags and pillows! There is space to sleep up to 50 people comfortably upstairs and downstairs in our learning center. Restroom facilities are in the Visitors' Center and refrigeration is available upstairs. No showers or indoor cooking facilities are provided; however, a variety of restaurants are located within three miles and pre-purchased meal options are available. *Due to health and safety regulations with federal, state, and local mandates, as well as differing policies between Girl Scout Councils, lodging capacity is subject to change.*
 - Upon acceptance of your deposit, receipts and fact sheets with further instructions will be emailed to you. A confirmation and schedule will be emailed upon receiving your registration form, roster, and payment in full.
 - Please note who the first aider is with your group when sending your roster. You MUST have a first aider for overnight programs! First aid supplies are available as needed. Lincoln Caverns' staff are certified in first aid and CPR, in the event your first aider is unavailable.
